

Adams County Sheriff's Office Employee Benefits

As an employee you will receive Adams County Employee Benefits, plus you will receive the additional benefits listed below as a member of the Sheriff's Office.

ACSO Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

The EAP offers counseling services for a wide range of life problems, including individual stress, marriage/relationship discord, grief resolution, and substance abuse issues. Any assistance or consultation is completely confidential. The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) offers free counseling to employees and their dependents. Services such as hospitalization, psychological testing, or medication monitoring are outside the scope of this program. If such services are necessary, they will facilitate referrals to utilize existing insurance coverage and minimize the cost to the individual.

Short Term Disability Insurance

This plan is administered by Northwestern Mutual. This plan covers you the first 90 days of sickness prior to long term disability. Payment starts the 8th day of disability. Pays 70% of your income up to \$1000/wk if you are using your sick time, you will be receiving your normal paycheck in addition to 70% of your income from Northwestern. If you do not have any sick time accrued, this plan will still pay you 70% of your income up to \$1000 per week. This plan does NOT cover Workers' Comp on-the-job injuries.

Colonial Life & Accident Insurance

Coverage is available with membership in the FOP. This plan pays you benefits for accidental injuries, which occur, on the job or off the job. This plan supplements your income while you are totally disabled and unable to work and provides additional income while you are hospitalized.

Membership in the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge #1

The Fraternal Order of Police Colorado Lodge #1 has over 300 members. Membership is open to all Sheriff's Office employees.
