THE Adams County Sheriff's Office Is releasing the following information pursuant to colorado revised statutes 16-13-901 through 16-13-905, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when the offender has been determined to be a sexually violent predator and is subject to community notification. The purpose of this notification is to enhance public safety and protection. Vigilantism, or use of this information to harass, threaten, or intimidate any of the following people is criminal behavior and will not be tolerated: the offender, the offender's significant others, and the community notification team.

FURTHER DISSEMINATION OF THIS BULLETIN BY CITIZENS IS DISCOURAGED. ADDITIONAL COMMUNITY MEMBERS NEEDING INFORMATION SHOULD BE REFERRED TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

THE INDIVIDUAL SUBJECT OF THIS NOTIFICATION HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A SEX OFFENSE THAT REQUIRES LAW ENFORCEMENT REGISTRATION. FURTHER, THEY HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO PRESENT A HIGH POTENTIAL TO RE-OFFEND AND ARE THEREFORE SUBJECT TO COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION REGARDING THEIR RESIDENCE IN THIS COMMUNITY.

THIS LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY HAS NO LEGAL AUTHORITY TO DIRECT WHERE A SEX OFFENDER MAY LIVE. UNLESS COURT RESTRICTIONS EXIST, THEY ARE CONSTITUTIONALLY FREE TO LIVE WHEREVER THEY CHOOSE. SEX OFFENDERS HAVE ALWAYS LIVED IN OUR COMMUNITIES, BUT THEY WERE NOT REQUIRED TO NOTIFY LAW ENFORCEMENT OF THEIR RESIDENCE UNTIL REGISTRATION LAWS WERE IMPLEMENTED PURSUANT TO THE JACOB WETTERLING ACT IN 1994. LAW ENFORCEMENT MAY NOW SHARE THAT INFORMATION WITH MEMBERS OF THEIR COMMUNITIES, AND IN THE CASE OF SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATORS, LAW ENFORCEMENT MUST ACTIVELY NOTIFY CITIZENS.







Golorado Sex Offender Legislation

- The legislature determined that Sexually Violent upon their release from Department of Corrections community at large and therefore mandated that Predators (SVP) by definition pose a higher risk to the (DOC), the community must be notified.
- An SVP maybe be more likely to be arrested for a violent crime within five years upon release from

Community Notification in Colorado

Occurs 2 ways in Colorado:

- Passive and ongoing: through the sex offender registration process
- for those sex offenders determined by the courts to Active: via Community Notification be Sexually Violent Predators (SVPs)



- Most sex offenders engage in CROSSOVER behavior
- Many sex offenders have NO criminal history.
- be deceptive, manipulative, & secretive. There is no "typical" sex offender, but all tend to



- 80-95% of sex offenses are committed by someone known to victim
- Sexual deviancy often begins in adolescence
- Sex offenses are not impulsive, they are usually carefully

Most sex offenders are male, only 4% are female

Community Responsibility

- The community has vested interest in helping the offender be successfully managed in the community
- Sex offenders have the same need for housing & employment as other citizens
- Harassment is counter-productive to goals of community management & may cause the offender to go underground
- ANY CITIZEN WHO USES THIS INFORMATION TO PROSECUTION OFFENDER WILL BE SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL HARASS, THREATEN, OR INTIMIDATE THE



- States There are nearly 400,000 sex offenders across the United
- registered sex offenders in Colorado. As of 7-2-2019 there are approximately 19,696
- As of 7-2-2019 there are approximately 230 SVP's on the website
- offenders in unincorporated Adams County Colorado As of 7-2-2019, there are approximately 493 registered sex
- Approximately 65% of convicted sex offenders are placed on probation in CO., (rest to DOC & community corrections.)

- risk to commit another type. Offenders may be caught for one type of offense, & be at high
- Crime of conviction is only one indicator of risk.

acts & Statistics Aloout Sex offending (cont o)

- Majority of sex offenders are not caught or detected
- Less than 16% of sex assaults are EVER reported.
- In Co., 1 in 150 women & 1 in 830 men have been reported to police, 1 in 4 women & 1 in 17 men have sex assault victims in the past 12 months, 16% were been sex assault victims in their lifetimes.

Tetims of Sex Ottenses mpact on

• Victims exhibit many different responses: crying, angry, quiet, withdrawn. No "normal" response.

Sex assault by someone known to victim creates a more

difficult recovery.

• Victims often develop post-traumatic stress disorder

. Long-term effects include; depression, anxiety, eating loss of concentration, sleeping disorders, and suicide disorders, flashbacks, divorce, loss of sexual interest,

Male victims tend to develop anti-social behaviors; females tend to develop depression; both can develop substance abuse problems

Responses are minimized when victims are believed & supported



- D. The offender persisted in the introduction of sexual content or inappropriate behavior of a sexual nature despite lack of consent or in the absence of consent.



Criteria for SVP

- 4: Positive results, or the "passing of a risk assessment instrument", which includes
- an assessment for the presence of: mental abnormality;
- level of denial regarding the offense;
- ottense; treatment appropriateness and motivation;
- presence of sexual deviant interests.
- Administered by:
- → Probation/parole staff AND a qualified treatment evaluator, approved by the SOMB
